COMMENCEMENT

The scheme was commenced with effect from 21.6.2007 by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India.

OBJECT

The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the poor and meritorious students belonging to minority communities (Sikhs, Muslims, Christians, Buddhists, Jains & Parsis) to enable them to pursue professional and technical courses.

ELIGIBILITY & CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship is given to students to pursue degree and/or post graduate level courses from Technical, Professional, Nursing, Pharmacy, Management etc institutions. Scholarship is awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks in the previous final examination and the annual income of the parents/guardian from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2.50 lacs. A student should be resident of Punjab State and regular in attendance. Scholarship will not be given to more than two students in a family.
